CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL (NORTHWICH CHRISTMAS EXTRAVAGANZA 2024) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024)

Whereas the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") being the traffic authority for the length(s) of road listed in the Schedule to this Order, (hereinafter called "the Highway") is satisfied that traffic on the Highway should be prohibited by reason of the proposed event to be executed on or near the Highway.

Now therefore, the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

NORTHWICH CHRISTMAS EXTRAVAGANZA 2024

- No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed on the Highway listed in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes or to a statutory undertaker's vehicle being used in a case of emergency.
- This Order shall come into operation on 23rd November 2024, and will be enforced between the times indicated in the Schedule, and may be cited as the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (NORTHWICH CHRISTMAS EXTRAVAGANZA 2024) (Temporary road Closures) Order 2024.

Schedule 1

Roads to be closed

The following lengths of road will be closed from 06:00 to 20:00. Meadow Street (From Sheath Street to Witton Street) Witton Street (From Meadow Street to Venables Road

The following lengths of road will be closed from 16:30 to 17:00. A533 London Road (From A5509 Chester Way to A533 Dane Street) A533 Dane Street (From A533 London Road to A559 Watling Street)

The following lengths of road will be closed from 16:45 to 17:30 Tabley Street (entire length)

The Order will come into force on Saturday 23rd November 2024 and will continue in force between the above times

Pedestrian access to premises situated on or adjacent to the roads will be maintained at all times.
