Garden Quarter Christmas Light Switch On

(Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2024

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council intends to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on following roads in Chester City to enable the Garden Quarter Christmas Light Switch On community event to be carried out by organiser.

The Order will come into force on Friday 29th November 2024, with the following lengths of road to be closed for the duration from 17:00 to 20:30 as detailed below.

Roads to be closed

- Garden Lane (entire length from Bouverie Street to Cheyney Road).
- Louise Street (entire length).
- Orchard Street (entire length).
- Plum Terrace (entire length).
- Cambrian Road (from Garden Lane to the pedestrian walkway).

ALTERNATIVE TRAFFIC DIVERSION

- Bouverie Street.
- Cheyney Road.

Pedestrian access to premises situated on or adjacent to the roads will be maintained at all times.

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.

The promoter of the event is the Garden Quarter Association.
