## CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL (WINDSOR DRIVE AND CASTLE DRIVE, WHITBY) (PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES) ORDER 2025

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 18<sup>th</sup> of March 2025 Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council made the above Order under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which comes into effect on the 28<sup>th</sup> March 2025. The effect of which will be to designate Windsor Drive and Castle Drive, Whitby as school streets. Vehicles will be prohibited to enter and proceed on Windsor Drive and Castle Drive, as indicated by signs, during the hours of 8:20am to 9:00am and 2.40pm and 3.30pm, Monday to Friday.

Access for residents will be maintained by the introduction of a school street permit scheme. Access to the properties in the restricted area is to be maintained for the delivery/collection of goods/services and passengers.

Statutory exemptions to emergency services and other vehicles used by the Council and utilities to be maintained.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may within six weeks from the 18<sup>th</sup> March 2025 make an application to the High Court for this purpose.
