Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984
Chinese New Year Festival
(Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2025

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 (1) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit all traffic as identified in Chester because of the likelihood of danger to the public for the Chinese New Year Festival on Saturday 1st February 2025.

The Order will come into force on Saturday 1st February 2025, with the following lengths of road to be closed from 10:30 to 12:15 as detailed below.

Roads to be closed:

- Northgate Street (from Princess Street to Eastgate Street).
- St Werburgh Street (entire length).
- Eastgate Street (from Northgate Street to Foregate Street).
- Foregate Street (from Eastgate Street to St John Street).
- St John Street (from Foregate Street to Little St John Street).

Pedestrian access to premises situated on or adjacent to the roads will be maintained at all times.

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
