## Trade, commercial or business waste

### Why can't I recycle this here?

This is a site for **HOUSEHOLD** waste and residential use only. This type of waste can only be presented at a location where commercial waste is accepted.

### Where can I recycle this item?

Trade, commercial or business waste is handled by commercial waste disposal companies. It is your responsibility to ensure correct disposal arrangements are carried out.

# Checklist

- ✓ It is your responsibility to ensure that your waste is transported and disposed of legally.
- ✓ Research thoroughly before paying someone to dispose of your waste.
- ✓ Anyone transporting waste for profit must have a Waste Carriers Licence. More information can be found at: [www.gov.uk/guidance/access-the-public-register-for-environmental-information](http://www.gov.uk/guidance/access-the-public-register-for-environmental-information)
- ✓ Ask to see a copy of a Waste Carriers Licence before anyone takes your waste away. (They must always carry a copy in their vehicle).
- ✓ Please keep details of the person taking your waste, including their name, vehicle details and Waste Carriers Licence registration number. If your waste is found fly tipped you could be prosecuted.

## Trade, commercial or business waste

Household Waste Recycling Centres (HWRCs) are provided for residents of Cheshire West and Chester to dispose of their own domestic waste. It is a criminal offence for businesses (regardless of their size) to use HWRCs and anyone caught may be fined £400.00 on-the-spot or prosecuted in court.
